## **Environmental Policy**

Wellsites is determined to achieving the highest standards of environmental performance and recognises its responsibility to the environment. Wellsites recognises that its operations have a direct and indirect environmental impact and aims to minimise that impact and operate in an environmentally responsible manner.

The following Principles apply to all current and future members of Wellsites and therefore will be acted upon in such a manner.

Along with adhering fully to local environmental legislation Wellsites will always try to find new ways to minimise its environmental impact.

## **Policy**

Wellsites will, so far as operationally practical:

- 1. Ensure that all relevant environmental legislation is applied
- 2. Operate all equipment used within Wellsites in an environmentally aware manner including:
  - o Powering down all non-essential equipment outside of working hours
- 3. All computers and equipment will be switched off when not in use.
- 4. Staff travel will be minimised and the lowest carbon mode of transport used wherever possible. If feasible a meeting will be held online or by conference call instead of travelling. If a journey is avoidable it will not be made.
- 5. Take care to purchase and dispose of consumables in an environmentally sensitive way and to reduce consumption wherever possible.
- 6. Recycle as much as possible; anything from printer paper to computer kit
- 7. Printing will be minimised, using electronic copies of documents wherever possible. Is printing is required we only use FSC certified paper
- 8. Send our work to clients for review via digital file transfer, removing any need to use printouts or the post
- 9. Ensure that people and/or companies associated with Wellsites are aware of our environmental policy where appropriate. This involves:
  - o Making clients aware of this environmental policy by email

## **Continuous Monitoring and Review**

Wellsites is committed to ensuring that the environmental impact of its operations is minimised wherever possible, and as such will ensure the environmental impact of our operations is continuously assessed:

- Ensure the company is in full compliance with all relevant statutory environmental legislation
